The executive (organizing) committee of ICAS2011 discussed about the influence of the disasterstricken Fukushima nuclear power plant and has decided to proceed with the congress as scheduled. In face of this situation, an urgent symposium on "Analytical Sciences Facing Radioactive Pollutions" will be organized, where the significance of sampling and accuracy in measurements of radioactivity under unexpected situations will be discussed in view of the responsibility of analytical chemists. Welcome reception originally scheduled on Sunday evening will not be held to express our sincerest condolences.

Environmental radioactivity in Kyoto has remained unchanged as reported by the Japanese Government (URL http://eq.wide.ad.jp/index en.html and http://mextrad.blob.core.windows.net/page/26 Kyoto en.html). The transportation system in Japan will be normally operated except for in some seriously damaged area. Therefore, we would like to encourage you to attend the congress.

The committee is, however, willing to reimburse the registration fees in full, if noticed in writing not later than Friday, April 22, to those who are not able to attend the congress due to inevitable reasons originated from the disaster.
